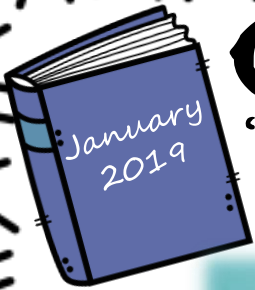

A few ideas to get your students excited about reading...

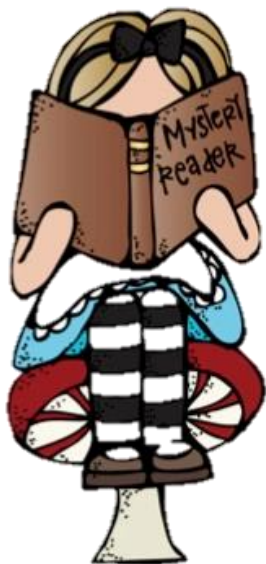
Tournament of the Books
